- **Itinerary**

Day 1: Arusha Coffee Lodge

After arriving at Kilimanjaro International Airport, you will be chauffeured to The Arusha Coffee Lodge. Surrounded by a working coffee plantation and facing Africa's fourth highest peak, the snow-capped Mt. Meru, the Arusha Coffee Lodge is a comfortable and serene start to your safari in northern Tanzania.

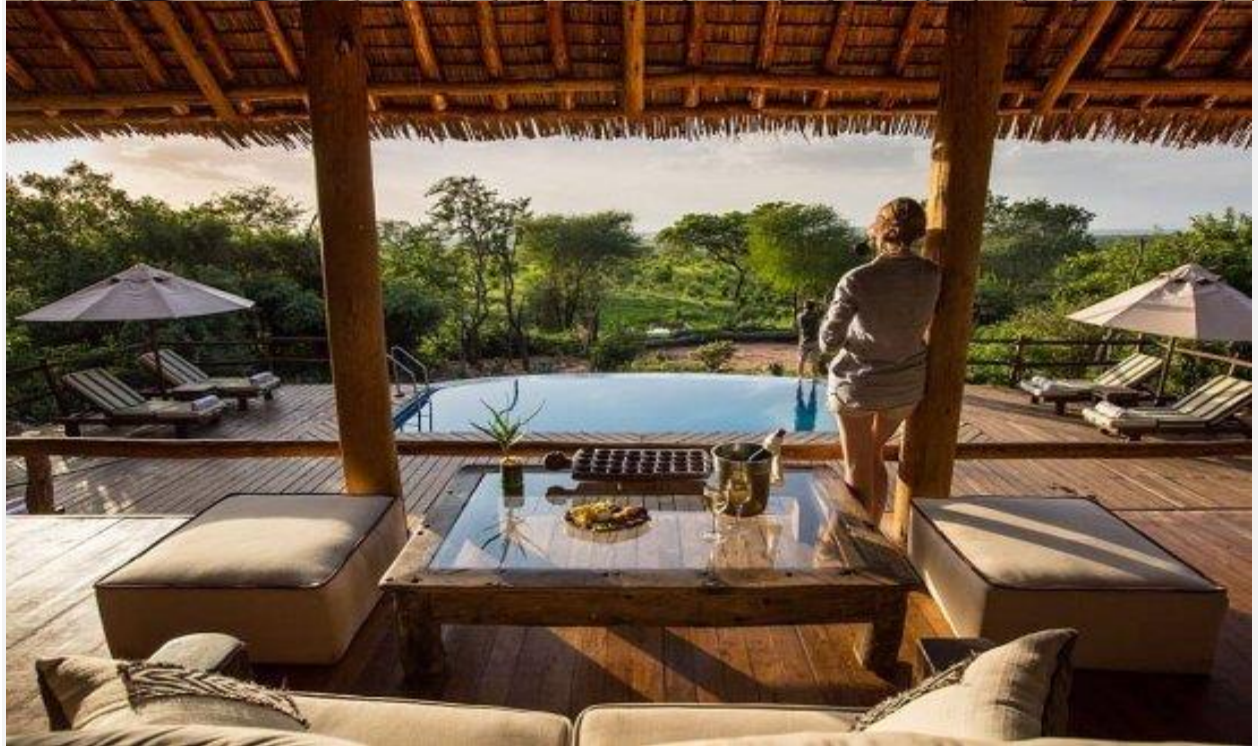


Day 2 - 3: Tarangire Treetops, Tarangire National Park

You will fly to Tarangire National Park where you will stay at Tarangire Treetops for two nights. Enormous suites have been built into baobab trees and the main deck overlooks a waterhole that is known for excellent elephant sightings. A highlight of this lodge is the walking safari. The walks are led by experienced guides who will invite you into an intricate world of plants and animals.

Day 4 - 5: The Manor at Ngorongoro, Ngorongoro Crater

You will fly to The Manor at Ngorongoro where you will spend two nights. The Manor offers panoramic views and is enveloped by lush gardens and ancient trees. The Ngorongoro Crater, Africa's Garden of Eden, is home to the Big Five and it is not uncommon to spot these mighty beasts on a single game drive. Furthermore, it remains one of the few places in the world to see the endangered black rhino, there are flamingos and hippo on Lake Makat and a huge variety of plains game, including wildebeest and zebra.

Day 6 – 7: Serengeti Migration Camp, Serengeti National Park

Today, you have the option of visiting the Lake Manyara National Park or staying at the lodge to explore the estate. After lunch you will fly to the Serengeti where you will stay for two nights. Tucked away in the vast plains, the Serengeti Migration Camp is located at the starting point of one of the world's great wonders – The Great Migration. Facilities include a split level lounge, cigar bar, a sun deck and swimming pool all perched amongst the rocky outcrops overlooking the vast and rugged landscapes.

Day 8 - 11: Kilindi Zanzibar, Zanzibar Archipelago

Fly to Kilindi Resort on the island of Zanzibar where you will spend four wonderful nights. This is certainly the way to experience the island of Zanzibar!
